VISION

We are working to alleviate poverty in South Africa through early childhood education and nutrition.

As we have continued to grow and expand, our mission and vision have always remained the same. We are passionate about working to alleviate poverty through early childhood education and nutrition. And none of the work we do is possible without the people that support us and believe in us and the work we are doing.

In 2021, we welcomed one team from our partner, Afrika Adventures and we were able to install a toilet and shower structure at Tembe's Patch as well as pick tons of chilis. The faces on Tembe's family as running water began to pour out of the shower was priceless. They are the only family in Ndwedwe with a proper shower! It was incredible to have a taste of what it felt like to have teams back on the ground.

2022 was filled with so much goodness and incredible moments, and also some devastation in the form of massive flooding in KZN that wiped out much of our progress from 2020 and 2021. After a long hiatus, trips were back in full force. We had the absolute pleasure of hosting 10 unique teams throughout the year that were eager to jump in and help us rebuild after loss.

In addition to hosting all of these teams, we were busy with much of the day to day work that often goes unrecognized. Thandi, our Community Director, hosted multiple agricultural training programs. All of our teachers in both Ndwedwe received ongoing education. We continued to invest in local relationships with chiefs and businesses. Our work with Thobani, a local civil engineer, deepened with the additional work of block making kicking into high gear. We received multiple Jungle Gym donations as a result of ongoing relationship building in South Africa. We brought on additional staff members in Ndwedwe and Kya Sand to match the growth in children. We committed to purchasing more meals from Rise Against Hunger to ensure all of the children are fed nutritious meals. Our partnership with Build the Future USA flourished with more people committing to the work here in South Africa. Last but certainly not least, in June we completed the construction of the bakery at Tembe's thanks to the support of our partner, Build the Future Netherlands.

We're so appreciative of every person that made the voyage across the ocean, contributed to someone's trip, made a donation, and shared the mission and vision of Build the Future with others. To say we are grateful is a vast understatement. We truly believe that the best is yet to come.

For the first time ever, Elizabeth and the team at Kya Sand organised and conducted the graduation ceremony all on their own.

10

students graduated from Ekusizkaleni Crèche (Preschool 3) and are now in grade R at a neighbouringschool.



Held year-end parties for the students at all of the preschools in Ndwedwe, giving out food parcels for the summer months.

Two teachers from Kya Sand graduated from Johannesburg Childcare College.



In 2022, between our programs in JHB and KZN, we welcomed 10 teams consisting of

200
people.

Major floods in KZN wrecked havoc on multiple projects, setting us back quite a bit.

Construction and completion of Preschool 4 with the support and funding from a donor in honour of their son.

Making more blocks through a community development project. Our micro-entrepreneur partnership with Thobani is creating more jobs for people in the community. We will be purchasing the blocks from Thobani's block-making business to build new preschools as we receive funding.



Sponsoring **4** people attending Farming God's Way to learn how to properly and safely farm.



Improving production of agriculture at Tembe's Patch through the studies at Farming God's Way and learning about using organic fertiliser and using more land.



Completing multiple honey harvests with the addition of two more hives with plans for more.



Upgrading the bakery to be able to produce more by adding an additional oven.



We are planting additional crops at the Waterfall garden to grow our capacity to feed both the school and the surrounding community.



Replacing plumbing on all piping to school at Waterfall.

Improving physical education in Kya Sand with addition of obstacle courses.
